THURSDAY NIGHT RECAP

Donovan's 44, Fritz Bulls 35

Tanner Chesney had 22 points, 9 boards and 4 steals as the Donovan's rolled to a win as they began to distance themselves from Fritz and dBar in the Rec Division. Tanner added the play of the game - a three off of an inbound that ended the first half and gave the Donovan's a comfortable 24-11 lead.

The Bulls once again faced a feisty full court pressure throughout the first half which set the tone for the Donovan's victory. Jose Echevarria added a bunch of nifty moves around the basket. Michael Holley scored 12 points in the loss. The Donovan's won the season series with the win and will play Fritz again this weekend in a likely precursor of a first round playoff match-up.

Club Café 62, Manhunt 55

Club Café avenged last week's overtime loss to Manhunt by winning their makeup game 62-55. Jamie Nancarrow scored 25 points and had 10 rebounds while Peter Stacey had 15 points and hauled in 11 rebounds. Guard Gary Freeman added 11 points, 7 rebounds and 5 assists for the Rush. The game was back and forth throughout the first half. At the end of the first half Peter got an offensive rebound off his own miss and like Tanner in the game before hit a shot at the buzzer which tied the game at halftime 26-26.

Club Café tightened things up defensively and used a 16-6 run to open the second half to give them a 42-32 lead. Manhunt used a barrage of three point attempts in the last 4 minutes of the game and got two from Matt Olds and one from Matt Richenthal to claw to within 61-55. Manhunt had two late looks from three-point range that would have cut it to a one possession game but couldn't connect. Matt R had 17 points, 6 assists and 5 rebounds in the loss.

American Idol - Thoughts on the Men

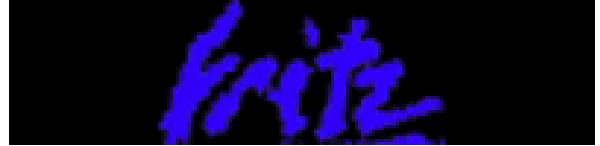
These four contestants - David Hernandez, Danny Noriega, Luke Menard, and Jason Castro - strike an uncanny resemblance to some celebrities.
